The letter requests the Mayor and City Council of Los Angeles to support the Commission by contacting the primary California state agencies overseeing implementing Proposition 41 and requesting funding for the City of Los Angeles that is in proportion to the homeless veteran population. ITEM NO. (5): UPDATE ON THE CITY HEALTH COMMISSION

Ricky Rosales, AIDS Coordinator, reported on Council File 14-0596 that established the Commission on Public Health.

The City Council's Budget & Finance Committee instructed that no meetings of the new Commission on Health be held until the City Council identifies a funding source for the new

Commission and confers with the City Attorney whether to amend the ordinance creating the Commission to eliminate the restriction on use of general funds.

ITEM NO. (6): CALIFORNIA COORDINATED CARE INITIATIVE.

DISPOSITION: ACTION TAKEN.

At its meeting of November 5, 2014, the Commission approved the motion that was relative to the Commission on Disability recommending the study of the Coordinated Care Initiative (CCI) and its impact on people with disabilities by inviting testimony from people with disabilities and from subject matter experts.

The Commission has invited guest to speak about the impacts of the California Coordinated Care (CCI) Initiative on people with disabilities, in particular, whether CCI has disrupted medical care during the passive enrollment process.

The Commission has also requested information about the program evaluation of CCI established by the Senate Bill that created CCI.

Neil Richman, Westside Center for Independent Living, briefly discussed a LA Times article on CCI and distributed a report discussing the design of CCI and is dated in July 2014. The report was by the Research Triangle Institute and sponsored by the Center on Medicare and Medicaid (CMS). The report provided the design of CCI and an evaluation protocol requiring the program to be monitored for implementation, evaluate its impacts, and discuss unintended consequences.

The Commission requested guest and Disability's staff to discover studies by the Department of Health Care Services, which were to be presented to the State legislature.

Commissioner Wilson indicated that although she doesn't receive Medi-Cal, she experienced her dental insurance changing, and so she asked the staff to investigate whether the State Insurance Commission might be of some assistance on all of these insurance issues.
